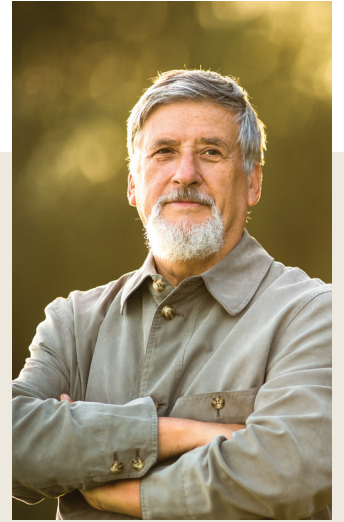

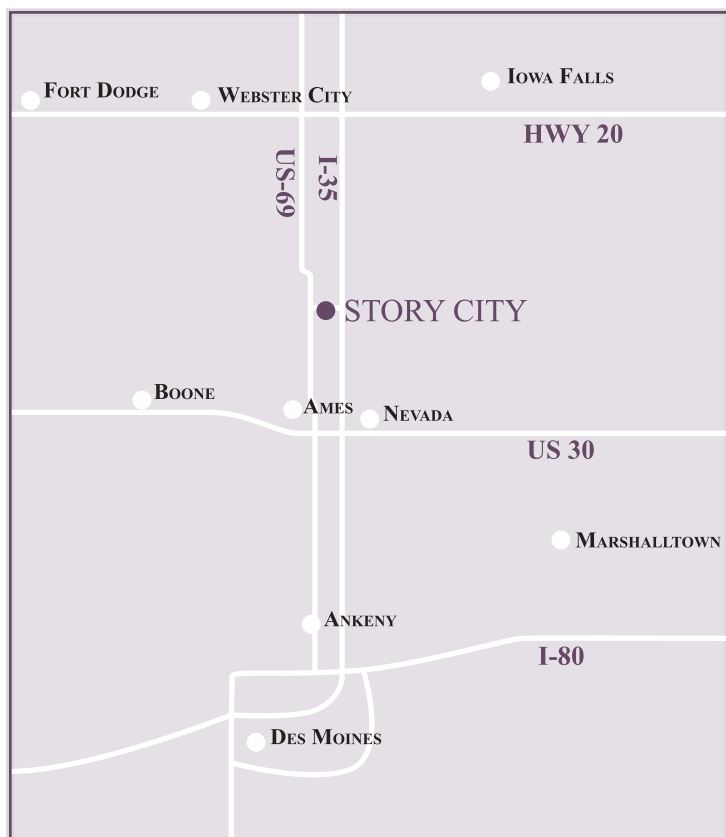

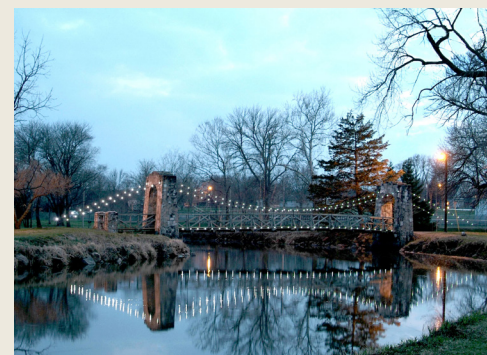
CENTRALIZED LOCATION

SPEECH THERAPY

At Bethany Life, we have access to some of the best Speech Language Pathologists and rehabilitation personnel. Our specialists help to evaluate and treat common rehabilitative issues such as swallowing disorders, work with you to develop safe diets that eliminate choking and aspiration dangers, and help you augment your nutritional food intake and hydration. Speech therapists can also assist with various forms of communication and cognitive functions.

OUR ON-SITE NURSE PRACTITIONER

Our practitioner works with all of the McFarland Clinic doctors and is intimately involved in the care of each resident. Their services ensure both prompt response times and proactive care. Our Nurse Practitioner is available to residents of The Households of Bethany anytime.

What is your room availability?

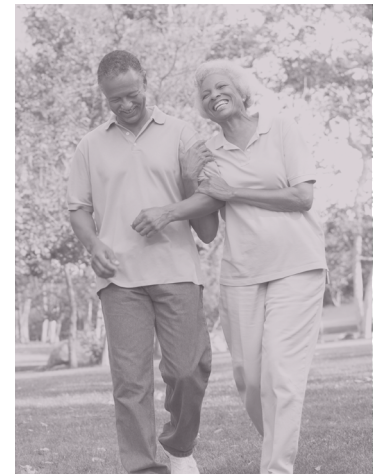

When can my family visit me?

While many places have “visiting hours” we want your family to be able to see you anytime. Visitors are always welcome. In addition, if your family needs transportation to be able to see you, we are happy to help arrange as needed.

What does my insurance cover?

Each individual situation is unique. In addition to working with all major insurance companies, we at Bethany Life employ specialists in Medicare and Medicaid to consult through the payment process.

Are there Add-Ons?

At Bethany Life, your daily rate includes amenities and there are no add-ons. We provide toothbrush, toothpaste, denture cleaner, deodorant, lotion, and incontinent products in addition to products required for basic needs, such as showering. We also provide transportation to doctor appointments free of charge.

How do I get there?

We offer free transportation from the hospital to our site in Story City. We are happy to arrange a convenient time for you, your family, and the hospital team.



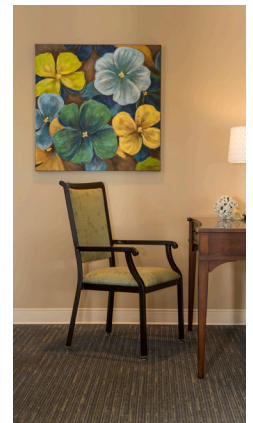
BENEFITS OF AQUATIC THERAPY

Our 98 degree therapeutic pool offers many advantages and benefits to individuals recovering from all phases of injury or illness. The scope of patient diagnoses treated in our pool is surprisingly vast, encompassing everything from post-surgical, non-surgical, orthopedic, rheumatic, and neurological to chronic pain. It is the therapeutic properties of the water combined with the skill and specialized training of our aquatic therapists that will help you to improve your mobility and function. You do not have to be a swimmer to participate in or benefit from water therapy.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who decides if my loved one qualifies for respite care?

The Bethany Life team will work with your loved one's primary care provider to ensure that care at the level offered at The Households of Bethany is appropriate for your loved one.

Is there a maximum stay?

There is no minimum stay and there is also no maximum stay, although after 29 days, your loved one would simply be considered a long-term resident rather than a resident in Respite Care.

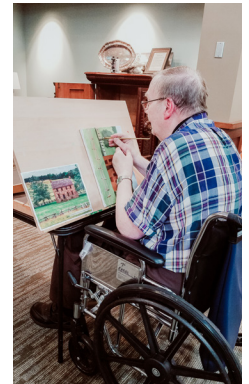
How much advance notice do you need?

Individual situations will vary. We do need enough time to get orders from your loved one's primary care provider and your loved one will need to have seen that provider within the past 30 days.

There is no maximum age and the minimum is 50 years. You must be living independently, must maintain health insurance, meet medical diagnostic criteria and live in the service area.

Is the pricing for one person or two?

Each member is entitled to his or her own separate care and service, which is why the pricing is per person even if they are joining as a couple.
